#### What is Scotland's Census?


- It's unique! A survey of everyone in Scotland, every ten years

#### **National Identity and Ethnic Group**

- The <u>Topic Consultation Report</u> was published in 2016
- We held a <u>Topic Event</u> in April 2017
- We proposed to collect National Identity and Ethnic Group in 2021
- We are not planning large changes to these questions
- We are currently reviewing elements of the National Identity and Ethnic Group Question content and design





### **Ethnic Group**

- We have listened to the views of a range of stakeholders
- One particular requirement is to capture more detailed data about African ethnic groups:
  - Because different groups are of interest for health analysis and/or equality monitoring;
  - For consistency with the rest of the ethnic group question where countries are indicated
